I strongly object to this planning proposal, for many reasons such as there has been no vetting procedure on these people who will no doubt will be majorly scared mentally from where they have come from, and no proof that these people have not been party to atrocities that have taken place within their own country, there is no one to oversee the curfew times and enforce them, meals are not catered for them, so thats 240 unvetted men hanging around Drewry lane and the town, which already feels unsafe to walk for my mother and most females I speak to in the area, not to mention school children that feel uncomfortable because of all the drunkards, drug users, homeless and beggars and anti-social behaviour that is already in this area. There are already 200 houses in Derby that home asylum seekers that are here in fear for their lives, how do you know that these unvetted men are not using this system to locate the previous asylum seekers that are fleeing from them. This can only make the area worse than what it is already, how many people will take their shopping business away from Derby when there will be gangs of intimidating men, begging and foraging all over town, how vulnerable will our young students be who live in the area, especially women will this have an impact on. What a great example to our overseas students. This area of Derby is cheaper accommodation for young families starting out, young students and a community of elderly people, not really the appropriate environment for this kind of housing. In spite of claims from other IA sites having no problems, you only have to look at what is happening in Europe, which is why most people voted to separate, it certainly isn't going to improve the area in any way whats so ever. The only thing it will improve is the bank balance of who will receive the government funding from this project.
